Because of the imminent risk to boys arising from the lack of judgment on the part of the Green Mountain Council of the Boy Scouts of America, we are departing from our usual newsletter format to bring the following critical information to your attention.

It is the policy of the BSA nationally to disallow homosexual leaders; homosexual men are not permitted to work with boys. However, as the following material will show, the Green Mountain Council has chosen to disregard that policy and put boys at risk.
